Vehicle Preparation for Event

- x All glass, liquids (including but not limited to: coolant, gasoline, washer fluid, and automatic/manual transmission fluid), fuel tank(s), and battery must be removed from the vehicle before being brought onto campus.
- x The vehicle can be delivered no more than two hours prior to the event and needs to be removed no more than two hours after the event.

Participants

- x Only one person at a time may participate.
- x Participants are required to:
 - Sign a Waiver to participate—Waiver provided by the Office of Risk Management and collected by event sponsor prior to participating.
 - Wear Safety Goggles (full surround)
 - Wear heavy duty work gloves.
 - Wear Closed Toed Shoes
 - Combination hard hat and face shield
 - Always remain on the ground (cannot stand on the vehicle or anything else at any time)
- x No Minors (18 and under) can participate (even with a waiver signed by a parent/guardian)
- x Sponsoring group should always have someone on site to monitor the activity.

Conclusion of Event

- x The sponsoring group is responsible for ALL cleanup and disposal.
- x Arrangements must be made to remove/tow the
