Course Success by Modality This is a combined request for dental hygiene and dental assisting. The scanners will be shared between both programs. Students of the dental assisting program are required to learn how to use a digital scanner by the Dental Board of California (DBC). RDA programs are required to learn students all supervised duties outlined by the DBC, perform a digital scan using imaging technology, when used specifically as a final impression and after inspection by the licensed dentist to confirm accuracy before milling rest fabricated, 3D printed, or 3D-fabricated restorations, crowns, or prosthetic devices. The college is intentionally placed in an area where this technology is rapidly replacing traditional materials. Many dental offices are now using digital scanning versus traditional impressions. Many of the existing offices that our students go to use this particular digital scanner. The program purchased a digital scanner several years ago, but the company is no longer supporting the scanner software or hardware used to use the device. This is a combined request for dental hygiene and dental assisting. The scanners will be shared between both programs. The hero scanner requires being connected to a laptop computer to function. We are requesting for 2 laptops for the 2 scanners. Students need to learn how to assemble the hardware (cabinet and mirror base, which is removed from the dental chair) that are used by dental assistants are not allowed to use these for their intended purpose of cutting hard or soft tissues. They must also know how to sanitize and maintain the equipment. The current handpieces that we have are 20 years old and are no longer used in current dental offices. These updated handpieces will allow our students to be familiar with the newer types used in their externship offices. This will benefit all students including those who are disproportionately impacted to complete their degree and certificates and be employed in their field of study and obtain a living wage.
